Mastic is also used to seal fire ducts and smoke ducts when crossing walls or other structures. Mastic can also be used around metal pipes and electrical cables to restore the fire resistance of wall and floor structures with openings for communication. Pyroplex® CE intumescent acrylic mastic has high-temperature expansion properties. The intended function of the mastic is to restore the fire resistance of the fire compartment, tested in accordance with EN 1366-3 and EN 1366-4. Mastic can provide fire resistance for up to 240 minutes, depending on the application and the base material. Application temperature: + 5 ° C to + 25 ° C,


